

Fireworks Safety



SUPERVISION

- · Wear safety glasses.
- Always have adult supervision.



DISPOSE CORRECTLY

- Correctly dispose of all unused fireworks.
- Keep a bucket full of water or garden hose nearby.



NO ALCOHOL

 Alcohol and fireworks do not mix.



REMEMBER

- · Stand back after lighting.
- Always place on a hard level surface.



DIRECTIONS

 Read directions and never experiment with homemade fireworks.



PETS

· Always keep pets indoors.

Tips to follow to ensure a fun, safe holiday with fireworks:

- Always read and follow directions from the label.
- · Make sure an adult is present.
- · Only use fireworks outside.
- Keep water handy- a garden hose and a bucket of water.
- Never experiment with or make your own fireworks.
- · Only light one firework at a time.
- Never re-light a "dud" firework (wait 15 to 20 minutes after trying to light it, then soak it in a bucket of water).
- · Small children should never have access to fireworks.
- If you aren't using the fireworks right away, it's best to store them in a cool, dry place.

- When the fun is over, dispose of fireworks properly by soaking them in water and dispose of the fireworks in trashcan after 24 hours.
- Never throw or point fireworks at other people.
- Never carry fireworks in your pocket.
- Never shoot fireworks in metal or glass containers.
- The person lighting the fireworks should always wear eye protection and never have any part of the body over the firework.
- Stay away from illegal explosives.
